

- \$25,000 Carnegie Grant Winner & AMERG Laboratory Launched At FUTA
  - Dr. (Mrs.) Oluwatoyin Olaseinde, corrosion engineer, RISE scholar and a senior lecturer of the Federal University of Technology Akure (FUTA) wins the \$25,000 Carnegie grant and has set up the Advanced Materials and Electrochemical Research Group (AMERG) with the aim of instituting a training the trainers research group at the University.

  - Alex Ndubuisi Nwegbu, Director General of the Nigerian Geological Survey Agency (NGSA), has been elected and sworn in as President of the Organization of African Geological Surveys (OAGS) for the next three years.

  Lagos State Governor, Mr. Akinwunmi Ambode has
  received the Certificate of Admission of the State as one
  of the 100 Resilient Cities (100RC) in the world pioneered

  - Twelve (12) Nigerian lecturers and scientists have been awarded fellowships by the African Academy of Sciences (AAS) and the Association of Commonwealth Universities (ACU) to study the impact of climate change in thematic areas of agriculture; energy; health and livelihoods; water; and policy. They make up the 37 African lecturers and researchers scientists selected as Visiting Fellows of the Climate Impact Research Capacity and Leadership Enhancement (CIRCLE) fellowship programme.
