

- 2. UNILAG Obtains NBC TV License In Nigeria The University of Lagos, Akoka (UNILAG), has become the first university in Nigeria to be granted a license to operate a television station.
- 3. D'Tigers Win 2017 FIBA Africa 3x3 Championship D'Tigers of Nigeria have emerged the inaugural champions in the men's category of the 2017 FIBA Africa 3x3 Cup beating Cote d'Ivoire in the final game.
- 4. Silas Adekunle Builds World's First Gaming Robots
 Silas Adekunle, the founder and CEO of Reach Robotics,
 has developed the world's first gaming robots called
 MekaMonsters, a multi-functional connected battle bot
 with augmented reality capabilities.
