
PositiveNaija (since 15 January 2015) is a multimedia news platform and institution committed to the culture of positive excellence of Nigeria and Nigerians globally.

2. EndSARS Youth Movement

EndSARS Youth Movement (The Messengers of Hope) emerges The Guardian's Person of the Year 2020.

3. Fisayo Soyombo

Fisayo Soyombo alongside two others have emerged winners of the 2020 Kurt Schork Awards for their reporting on conflict, corruption and injustice.

4. Iroro Tanshi

Iroro Tanshi has emerged winner of the Future for Nature Awards 2020 alongside two others out of 124 entries from other parts of the world.

5. Dagona Usman Umar

Dagona Usman Umar has emerged winner of the Imagine National Chemistry Competition 2019/2020 [Nigeria]. He won the 2020/2021 (round 2) with a score of 392 (out of (500).

6. Stripe Acquires Paystack

Payment processing giant Stripe has acquired Nigerian startup Paystack in a \$200 million plus deal, making it the biggest startup acquisition in Nigeria as well Stripes biggest acquisition to date.
